NISSAN is the first month of the Jewish calendar. Abib/Aviv is the Hebrew name and refers to the stage of growth when the grains have reached full size. It is the ‘first of months’ in the Hebrew year and a Passover month when we fully crossover into our Promises.

WELO is the third month both of the growing period and the dry season, and the fifth month of the year. Welo stands for ‘things that thrive’ because the earth is beautiful, all things grow well. Nana and Welo are productive months in Hawai’i and good for the land.

UNDERSTANDING THE THRESHING FLOOR

1. A flat smooth surface where grain is harvested and placed.
2. Animals would walk on the grain and crush the outer shell.
3. The grain is tossed with a winnowing fork and the wind blows to separate the chaff/rubbish from the good grain.

It was usually outside the village on a high elevated place with flat surface and strong, steady wind. Access by farmers in surrounding villages that may share the same threshing floor. It was a neutral space to gather, bustling with commercial and community activities.

“And rejoice in the Lord your God; For He has given you the former rain faithfully, And He will cause the rain to come down for you— The former rain, And the latter rain in the first month. The threshing floors shall be full of wheat, And the vats shall overflow with new wine and oil.” Joel 2:23-24

AT THE THRESHING FLOOR...

- Sin is dealt with and blown like chaff in the wind, Psalm 1.
- Mourning and sadness are left on the floor, Gen. 50.
- God provides a harvest to supply our needs, Num. 18.
- God reveals Himself and speaks to us, Judges 6.
- God redeems us as our kinsman-redeemer, Ruth 3.
- God pours out judgment and separates wheat and chaff.

“His winnowing fan is in His hand, and He will thoroughly clean out His threshing floor, and gather His wheat into the barn; but He will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire.” Matthew 3:12

RELEASE WORSHIP ON THE THRESHING FLOOR, 1 CHRON. 21

- David was tempted to number the people, Joab advised against it.
- God was displeased and a plague broke out then David repented.
- The prophet Gad gave David three things, David chose to come under the hand of God for His mercy is great, and not his enemies.
- Before striking the people of Jerusalem, God relented. The plague angel stopped and stood on the threshing floor of Ornan (Araunah).
- David purchased the threshing floor from Ornan and the surrounding lands...“And David built there an altar to the Lord, and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings, and called on the Lord; and He answered him from heaven by fire on the altar of burnt offering.”
- David prepares to build The House of the Lord God in Jerusalem.
- The threshing floor is on Mt. Moriah, where the Temple sits today.
