AV is the fifth month of the Jewish calendar and a "low point" in Jewish history. The 9th of Av is the day the people of Israel chose the negative report of 10 spies and refused to enter the Promised Land. It also marks the destruction of the first and second temples.

HINAI'A'ELE'ELE signifies dark clouds. This month takes on a dark ('ele'ele) beauty. The sky is dark with rain clouds just as the fruit trees are dark and heavy with ripened fruit. A time when little flies gather around fruits and in the uplands and late showers fall.

WALKING THROUGH...
"Connecting with the Lord"
Kealoha Ka'ōpua

"Dwell in Me, and I will dwell in you. [Live in Me, and I will live in you.] Just as no branch can bear fruit of itself without abiding in (being vitally united to) the vine, neither can you bear fruit unless you abide in Me. I am the Vine; you are the branches. Whoever lives in Me and I in him bears much (abundant) fruit. However, apart from Me [cut off from vital union with Me] you can do nothing."

NEVER ALONE

Jesus said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." (Heb. 13:5). Even in our alone time—the Lord is with us. He calls us to connect with Him and to dwell in the secret place (Ps. 91:1-2) with Him. When you pray, don't make an open show of it. But go into your room, shut the door and pray to your Father in the secret place (Matt. 6:5-6).

TWO OR THREE

Jesus said, "For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them." (Matt. 18:20). When we are a small group of 2-3 people, we have the power of connecting together in His name and with the Lord who connects with us. We cannot neglect the instructions to come together with others in the Body. Whether for prayer, counsel, studying the Word or for fellowship.

IN THE FAMILY

The biblical standard for family was established by God. The home was to be the place where we could connect to the Lord through the example of righteous authority that reflect love, protection and instructions. When this is absent. There is a disconnection from and a distortion of God. Eph. 5-6, Paul describes a healthy family lifestyle.

IN THE COMMUNITY

We have a God ordained obligation to be a person in the community that reflects or that lines up with our connection to the Lord. Does the reputation you carry in the community line up with God's Kingdom principles? If not, repent! We are expected to conduct ourselves as a child of the King. 1 Peter 4:11 remind us how to be when in public.

IN OUR WORSHIP TO JESUS

Repeatedly, the Lord has reminded us as the Ecclesia of Kona that we are called and anointed to produce a life of worship. Our life is a weapon of worship. Our songs and our declarations are a weapon of worship. Our conduct and obedience are a weapon of worship. Truly, we can walk through anything, when we walk in worship to the King!
