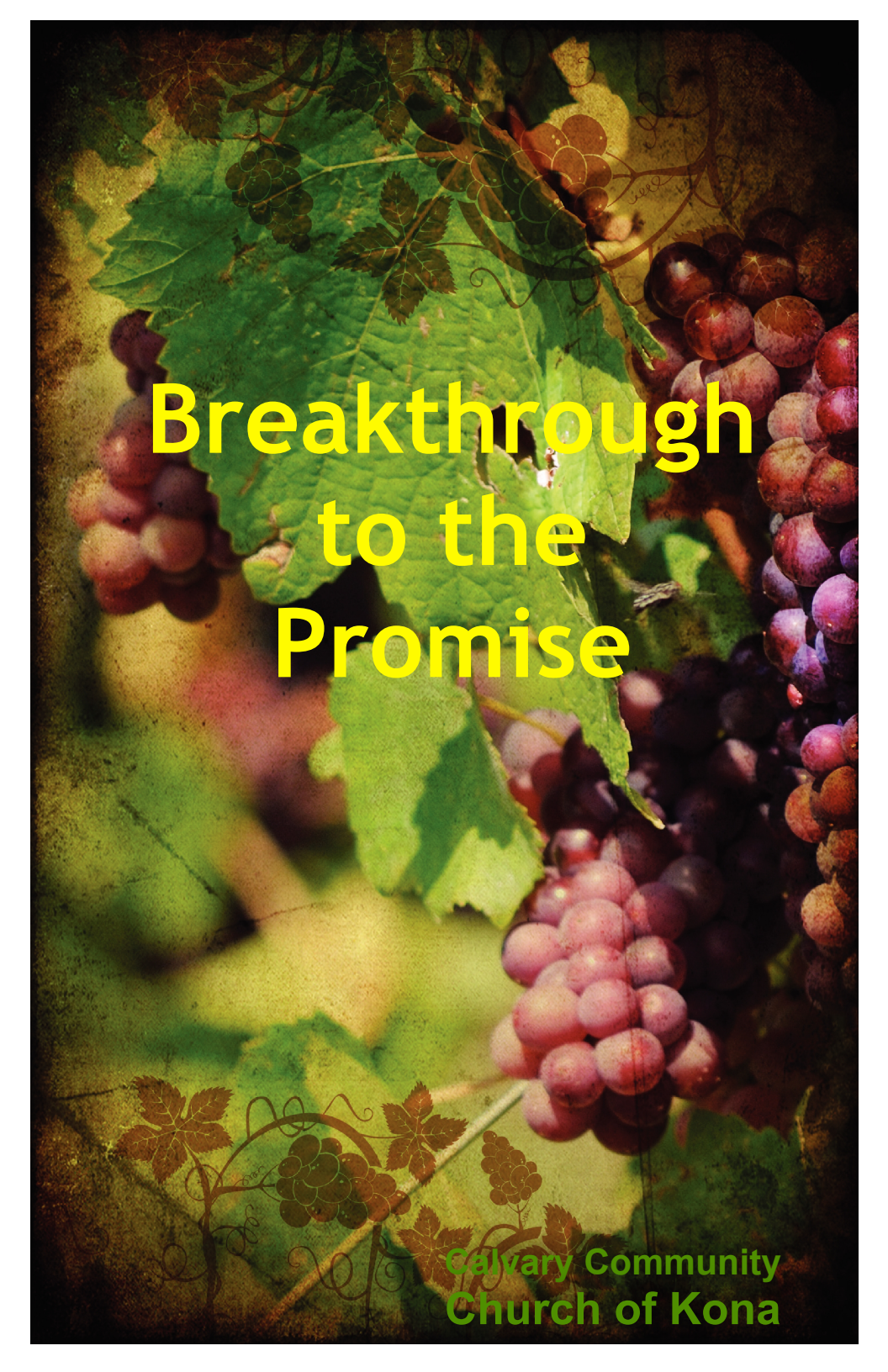

CURRENT AND COMING EVENTS

TODAY BREAKTHROUGH TO THE PROMISE is a necessary step to entering and possessing the promises of God. These are personal promises and personal prayer issues that you hold before the Lord. Like the children of Israel, we too need to break through the complaining, the negativity and our weak perspective so that we can “taste and see that the LORD is good.” It’s time for a breakthrough!

AUG 7 ‘OHANA SHABBAT, 6PM bring your ‘ohana and your dinner to enter God’s rest together. Kealoha and Taimane will lead.

AUG 8 PRIMARY ELECTION DAY for the State of Hawai’i. The Primary Elections selects the candidates from each party that will run in the General on November 3. This is as important as the General.

 **WAYS TO GIVE:** 1) We encourage bringing your tithes and offerings to the front during Worship as we view giving a part of our Worship to God. 2) A wooden box is set up at the back to receive your offering. 3) Use the QR code provided.

AV is the fifth month of the Jewish calendar and is associated with the tribe of Simeon. This is the “low point” in the Jewish calendar. The 9th of Av was when the people of Israel chose to receive the negative report of the 10 and refused to enter the Promised Land.

KA’AONA is the seventh month of the Hawaiian year and the fifth month of the dry season. This month signifies the ‘**ohia lehua** that blossoms with the light showers that fall. The ‘**ohia ‘ai** or mountain apple fruit also begin to swell and grow until rippened in October.

ENTERING AND POSSESING YOUR PROMISE FROM GOD:

When the Lord was ready to bring the people into their promised land, He had to send spies in first to SEE what He prepared for them.

Have you “seen” your promise?

2 Cor. 5:7, ***“we walk by faith and not by sight...”*** Faith is being convinced by God first. Even before you see the promise in real time or in reality. With this understanding, faith is more real than reality.

John 4:24, ***“God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.”*** Truth refers to “reality” a tangible quality. There is a realness to our worship to God. It is not just a spiritual quality. A true expression of worship is our obedience!

HAVE YOU “SEEN” YOUR PROMISES FROM GOD?

If **NO**: Then take this week to find an ‘abiding place’ and allow God to convince you of His promises. Then obey what He says to do.

If **YES**: Then get ready to enter and possess your promise from God. But be prepared as it may require you to do some spiritual warfare and dusting up in the spirit in order to enter and possess.

We Celebrate God's Times and Seasons Honoring our Covenant Roots in Yeshua

Celebrating God's Times and Seasons is not a legalistic pursuit for sanctification or salvation. It's a celebration of God in 'Ohana! God has a calendar and He sets appointed times to meet with us to celebrate and fellowship. The calendar we follow today was changed during the Dark Ages, but WE switched calendars - GOD DIDN'T! We are now in the Gregorian year 2026 but the Jewish year is 5786 (2025-2026) or **Pey Vav**. Hebrew numbers are words and began as pictures. This Hebrew decade "50" is **Pey** and it pictures a mouth and gives us expression, vocalization and speech; "6" is **Vav**, it pictures a hook, spear, club, a connecting pin, and a tent peg.

Prophetically: In this War Era we are to *Stake Our Claim and Be God's Vav in the Earth Realm!* This year is about connecting heaven to earth and claiming our inheritance! When you speak God's word, inspired by Holy Spirit, and act in obedience you become God's VAV!
